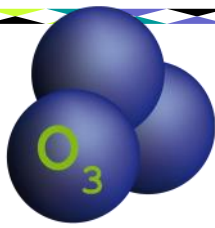

**Willie Watt will explain the interesting story of the Subsea 7 Wester Site which is the last of the original North Sea Fabrication sites in the UK.**

It was set up in the 1970s to provide pipelines for the industry and is still doing exactly that. The illustrated talk will cover the development of the site from its small beginnings to the world class facility it is today.

**Willie Watt will also describe the history and development of Wick Harbour from supporting fishing to energy related projects and other industries.**

He will show how the harbour has diversified away from fishing to provide sustainable income for many years to come and give huge opportunities and significant new jobs for Wick and Caithness.

**This talk will reflect on what is going on in Caithness in terms of Energy Projects - oil and gas work being delivered from Wester and offshore wind - BOWL project, Meygen in the Firth and Dounreay/Vulcan decommissioning.**
